AUTOPSY:

1. Complete:	\$2500
2. Chest and Abdomen (no head):	\$2000
2. Chest cavity only.	\$1000
3. Abdominal cavity only.	\$1000

5. Brain only with Neuropathology consult:	\$750

PERINATAL SPECIMENS:

1. Products of Conception, First Trimester:	\$125
2. Singleton Placenta, Second Trimester:	\$125
3. Singleton placenta, Third trimester:	\$375
4. Singleton Placenta, Third Trimester, 4 quadrant exam:	\$525
5. Twin placenta:	\$600
6. Triplet placenta:	\$750
7. Fetus - gestation of less than 20 weeks:	\$525
8. Fetus - gestation of 20 weeks or more, stillborn ³ :	\$525-1500
9. Infant - gestation of 20 weeks or more, live born ³ :	\$1500-2500
10. Placenta that accompanies a fetus or newborn:	\$125-250

MEDICAL-LEGAL WORK:

1. Examination of records and materials:	\$400/hr
2. Deposition (2 hr minimum):	\$500/hr ⁴
3. Trial Testimony:	\$4000/day ⁴

1. Most brain only autopsies will not qualify at the \$500 level and will require a Neuropathology consult resulting in a final charge of \$750.

2. Custom autopsy procedures (such as directed post mortem biopsies) will be assessed on a case basis.

3. An autopsy permit is required for these examinations. Cost varies based on age and condition of fetus or infant.

4. These fees must be paid in advance. Charges equivalent to 50% of the minimum apply if a proceeding is canceled without 24 hours notice. A 50% refund would follow. The retained 50% can be credited to a rescheduled proceeding.
